



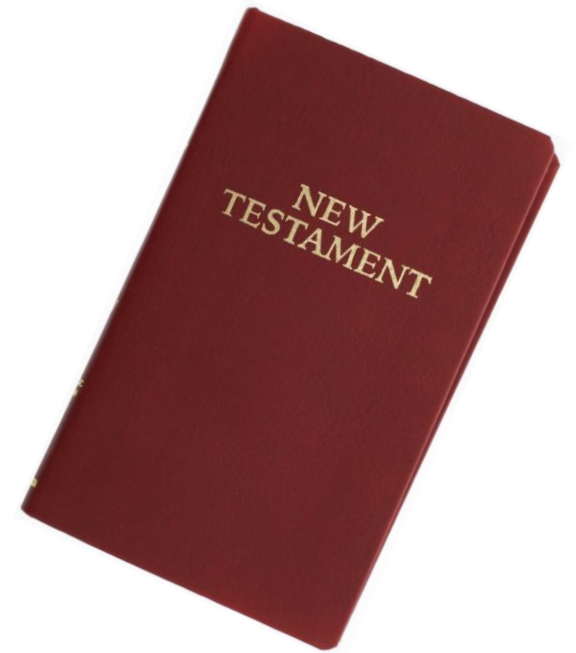

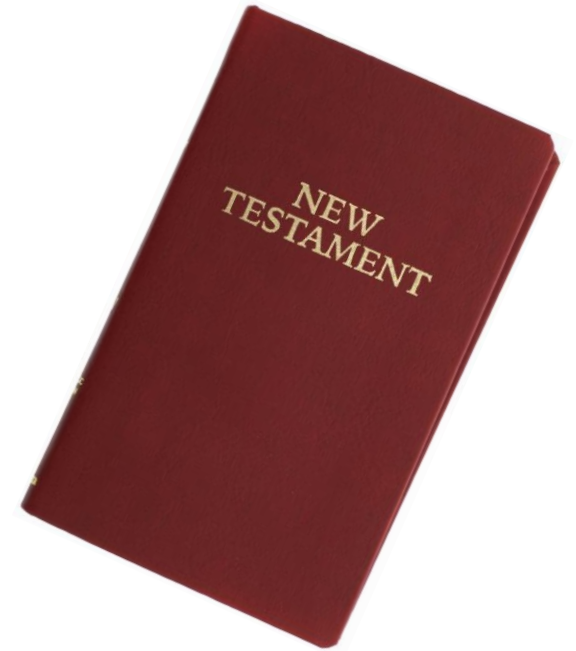

# Mark 16:9-20

## Evidence For Mark 16:9-20

Evidence for including these verses is staggering. When we look at the manuscripts of Mark's Gospel that survive today, more than 99 percent contain Mark 16:9-20. This includes not only 1,600-plus Greek manuscripts, but most manuscripts of early translations of Mark as well.

Moreover, by around AD 180, Irenaeus unambiguously quoted Mark 16:19 as Scripture in Against Heresies (3.10.6). Justin Martyr and Tatian likely knew the verses earlier in the second century as well. Undeniably, Mark 16:9-20 was considered by many Christians early on to be a part of Mark's Gospel.

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### Evidence Against Mark 16:9-20

There are effectively just two Greek manuscripts that lack Mark 16:9-20. These are codices Sinaiticus (X01) and Vaticanus (B03), two important manuscripts from the fourth century. It's almost unimaginable that the copyists who made them were unaware of Mark 16:9-20, but at the end of the day, they left it out of their Bibles.

## Mark 16 9 - 20

**Mark 16:9** [[Now when he rose early on the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons.

**Mark 16:10** She went and told those who had been with him, as they mourned and wept.

**Mark 16:11** But when they heard that he was alive and had been seen by her, they would not believe it.

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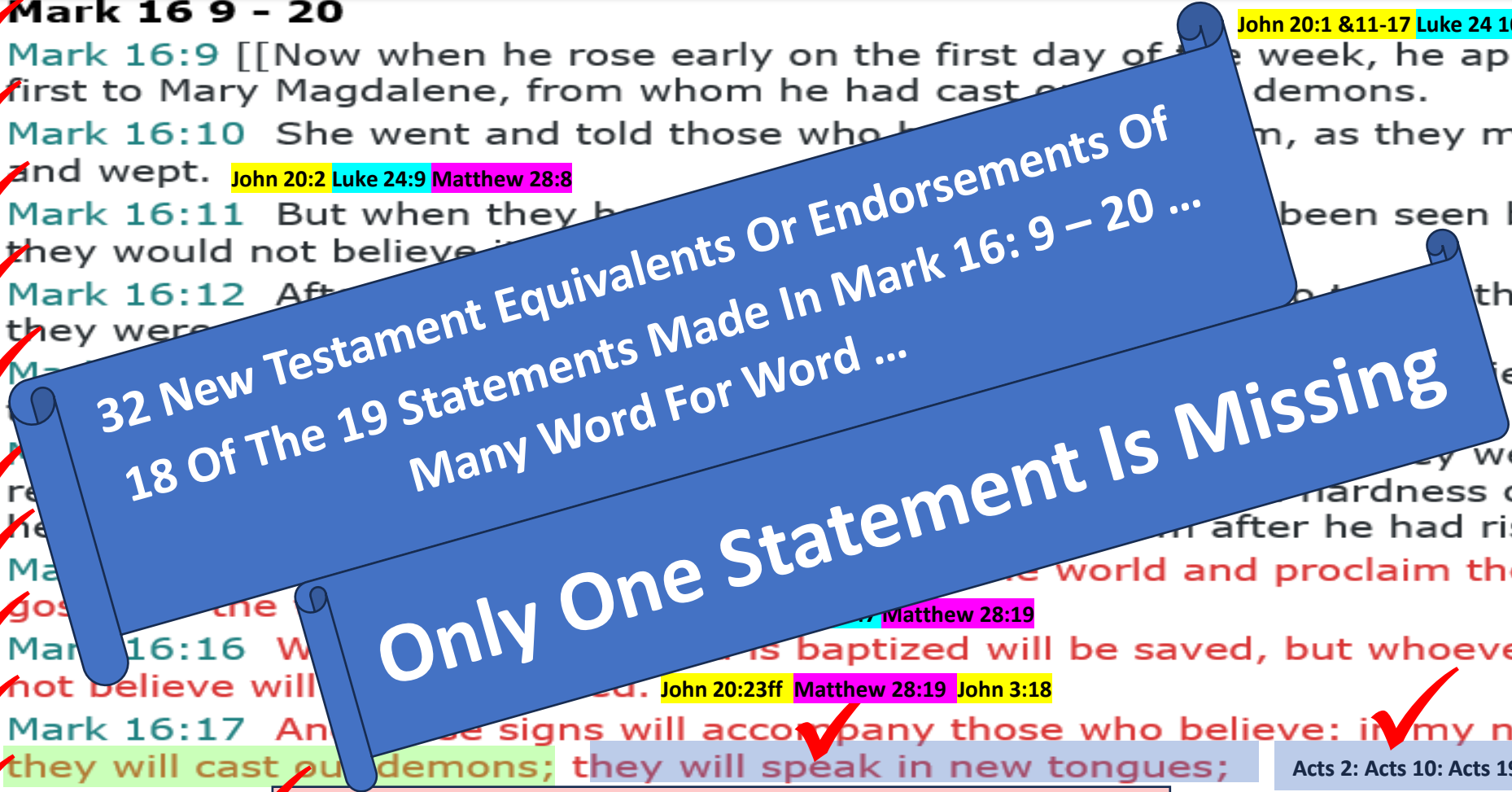

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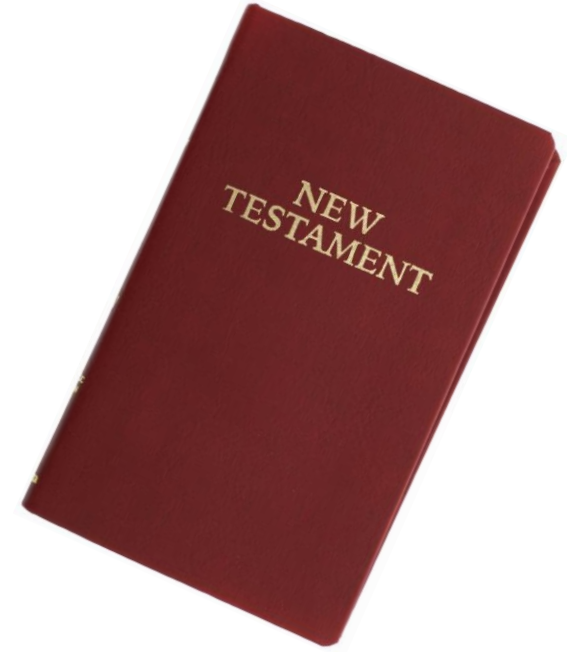
